We the patrons of Waysville sic) School and citizens of the community, sincerely request the Loudoun County School Board to reconsider the matter of closing the Daysville School for the term of 1924-25.

We present this petition as evidence of our interest in having a school at Daysville.

We respectfully ask you to consider a few things in our behalf.

Due to no cause of our own is the present enrollment so small for the last half of the term of 1923-24. The enrollment at the beginning of the term was twenty-three. Such a small enrollment has not been the case for any number of terms, nor for one whole term.

Has our percentage of attendance compared with that of the schools in general? Have we shown a lack of interest in our school?
